INTERVIEWS need to

be scheduled for Wednesday October 4, 2023 starting at 4PM.

Wooden Shoe Ranch: One \$300.00 scholarship will be awarded for the second semester of post-secondary education

Lange Scholarship: One \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded for the second semester of post-secondary education

Harrington Scholarship: One \$500.00 scholarship will be awards for the second semester of post-secondary education

Stan Allen Memorial Scholarship: One \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded for the second semester of post-secondary education

Rasmussen Trust: Three \$1000.00 scholarships will be awarded for the second semester of post-secondary education
